• Student vaccine requirement postponed until July 1, 2023, at the earliest. The requirement was meant to be in effect after the full FDA approval of the vaccine. Approval has not yet occurred, so the plan has changed.

Who must pay for COVID-19 tests?

o Per the <u>COVID-19 Testing</u> fact sheet, Dept. of Managed Health Care insurance companies must pay for COVID-19 tests

• Have there been changes to the weekly testing requirement for unvaccinated employees in K-12 schools? There have been no changes since the <u>August CDPH</u> <u>order</u>. This is a state decision outside the scope of negotiations between PUSD & PFT.
