Update on Governor's January Budget for 2022-23 & Negotiations

- PFT attended School Services of CA budget workshop January 21
- The PUSD Finance Dept is applying the Governor's January budget information to the PUSD budget. Once we know the impact to the PUSD budget, we can come back to the table to discuss finalizing a settlement for this school year (2021-22).
 - o So far, we have secured a 4% ongoing salary increase and no increases to out-of-pocket costs for health and welfare premiums
 - The 4% increase will be in our January pay warrant
 - The retro pay to July 1 will be in our March pay warrant
- 5.33% COLA in the proposed state budget for 2022-23
- PFT and the District will be "sunshining" negotiations so we can begin to discuss a settlement for 2022-23. Sunshining allows the public to comment on negotiation topics.

Update on Implementation of Late Start Legislation for 2022-23

- Schedules expected to be released by end of February
- District is working to ensure the least disruption to schedules as possible
