1. <u>Catastrophic Leave Drive Update</u>

The need for donations continues! Thanks to PFT unit members who have donated 875.5 hours or about 125 days to the catastrophic leave bank as of 9/17/19. The current donations would provide two qualifying unit members access to this leave for the full 50 days if needed. We need more donations to the bank, so no unit member is left without this option when in need. Donated hours in the bank are used when a permanent/tenured PFT bargaining unit member, or a member of his or her family, is incapacitated by an illness or injury for an extended period.
